The Carolinas CARE Partnership announces the release of its ***Request for Proposals*** for the Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) Program. These funds are administered in the Charlotte MSA (which includes Anson, Cabarrus, Gaston, Mecklenburg, Union and York S.C. Counties) by the Carolinas CARE Partnership. These funds are allocated to the City of Charlotte by the US Department of Housing and Urban Development.

HOPWA provides funding for housing and housing related services for those whose lives are affected by HIV. We hope your agency will consider applying for these funds. The application documents can be found at www.carlinascare.org under the housing link.

The proposals are due in our office by **5:00 p.m., Friday, February 17, 2012.**

As you read through the information, please bear in mind the following:

- Submit one original with signatures, one copy, and one electronic copy;
- Proposals may be mailed, sent by overnight express or hand-delivered;
- Faxed applications will not be accepted;
- Please be sure that your application is within the specific activities allowed under the HOPWA program and is within the Charlotte MSA;

- New agencies, those who have previously applied, and those who have previously been funded are all encouraged to apply;
