The Regional HIV/AIDS Consortium's History

The Carolinas CARE Partnership was formerly known as the Regional HIV/AIDS Consortium was established in 1990 by the United Way of the Central Carolinas, Inc., and the Foundation For The Carolinas. From the beginning, the Regional HIV/AIDS Consortium has sought to develop plans and services for its region without regard to state or county lines as the community struggled to meet the challenges brought on by HIV and AIDS.

The Regional Consortium has managed a multitude of programs including federal, state and local grants including:

- Ryan White Title II that provided comprehensive care and treatment services
- The Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) for essential housing and supportive services
- An AmeriCorps program that had many dedicated individuals who worked and provided community services in numerous AIDS service organizations.
- Substance Abuse Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) for the provision of substance abuse services

The Regional Consortium has also been the recipient of several major grants from foundations and organizations such as the National AIDS Fund, the J. Marion Sims Foundation, Phillip Van Every, Duke Endowment, Pfizer Foundation and the Sisters of Mercy.

Now that we enter into a new era as the Carolinas CARE Partnership, we look forward to providing programs, services and information that will assist our region in our fight against HIV/AIDS.

PROGRAMS

Federal Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA):

The HOPWA programs are designed to help individuals gain access to and remain in safe, stable housing. This program funds emergency financial assistance, supportive services, end-of-life care, and housing vouchers in an ongoing effort to prevent homelessness.

Training/Technical Assistance:

The Regional Training Institute will support the goals of the Regional HIV/AIDS Consortium and contribute to the success of our partners by offering high-quality, cost-effective training programs that facilitate personal and professional excellence, enhance organizational effectiveness, and contribute to a holistic approach to prevention, care and services in our community.

Non-Traditional Counseling, Testing and Referral Site Programs:

Through North Carolina's AIDS Care Unit The Regional HIV/AIDS Consortium's non-traditional counseling, testing and referral site programs are comprehensive programs to provide a continuum of care integrating prevention/outreach and HIV/STD counseling and testing in Mecklenburg, Cleveland, Cabarrus and Iredell Counties.

Prevention Program:

Through the Office of Women's Health The "Something to Talk About"--The ABC's of Living Healthy program (STTA) provides HIV prevention education for African-American women in several counties in North and South Carolina. STTA educates women living in these counties not just about HIV, but strategies for living healthy. It also provides opportunities for them to talk about HIV and other health-related issues in a safe, comfortable environment of other women just like them.

Collaborative HIV/AIDS Prevention and Mental Health Treatment Project (CHAMP):

A community-based participatory research grant that will be used to design, implement, and evaluate a home-based mental health treatment and HIV risk reduction intervention for HIV-infected individuals with mental disorders who may also substance abuse problems. This project involves a partnership between the Centers for Health Policy at Duke University

D-UP!

D-UP is a HIV prevention program targeted to young men of color ages 13-24 who are MSM (men who have sex with men). The five-year program is funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and is a cooperative agreement with the Regional HIV/AIDS Consortium. The D-Up! program implements Popular Opinion Leader (POL), a CDC community level intervention that focuses on HIV risk reduction through peer influence.

The Ryan White Program



An extremely important resource in our community is the Ryan White Part A program. The Ryan White Program works with cities, states, and local community-based organization to provide HIV-related services to more than half a million people each year. The program is for those who do not have sufficient health care coverage or financial resources for coping with HIV disease. Ryan White fills gaps in care not covered by these other sources.

Ryan White is administered by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), HIV/AIDS Bureau (HAB). Federal funds are awarded to agencies located around the country, which in turn deliver care to eligible individuals under funding categories called Parts.

Mecklenburg County is a grantee recipient of Part A Ryan White Treatment Modernization Act that provides HIV-related health and support services for people living with HIV/AIDS in our Transitional Grant Area (TGA) that includes Anson, Cabarrus, Gaston, Mecklenburg, Union, and York (SC) counties federal grant funds. HIV Case Management Services

The HIV Case Management Services (HIV CMS) is a client focused strategy for coordinating care that assesses a client's need for specific medical, social, and educational needs and facilitates access to services that will address those needs. HIV CMS is provided to those who are HIV+ and are eligible for services through the Medicaid or Ryan White programs. The services provided are also intended to:

- Improve a person's access to a wide variety of appropriate services
- Promote a continuum of care by coordinating service delivery arrangements
- Enhance a person's health status and level of functioning

 - Primary care
 - HIV specialty care
 - Lab work
 - Nutritional counseling & supplements
 - Treatment adherence counseling
 - Coordination of care with off-site medical specialists and dental care
 - Mental health counseling
 - Free, confidential, rapid HIV counseling and testing
 - Individual and group level interventions for people at high risk for HIV infection
 - Community-based outreach and education
 - Community partnerships for free condom distribution
